JUDGMENT OF DEFERRED ADJUDICATION ON CLASS 'C' CASE

On this the ____ day of _____, 20__ the above numbered and styled cause was brought before the Court and came the Assistant Criminal District Attorney for Smith County, Texas and came the Defendant by and through his Attorney, _____. The Defendant by and through his/her Attorney entered a plea of "GUILTY" to the charges as alleged and waived a trial by jury.
